

A partial DNA profile was obtained from Exhibit DMS-22A.

This partial DNA profile is consistent with originating from a male individual and matches the DNA profile from Trayvon Benjamin Martin (Exhibit ME-3 in FDLE case # 20120501890).

The frequency of occurrence of the partial DNA profile obtained from Exhibit DMS-22A for unrelated individuals is approximately 1 in 160 trillion.

There is the possibility of an additional contributor to the partial DNA profile obtained from Exhibit DMS-22A.

Exhibit DMS-22B swab from flashlight

Exhibit DMS-22B failed to give chemical indications for the presence of blood.

STR DNA analysis was performed on a sample from Exhibit DMS-22B utilizing the AmpF/STR Identifier Plus PCR Amplification Kit.

No DNA results were obtained from Exhibit DMS-22B.

REMARKS:

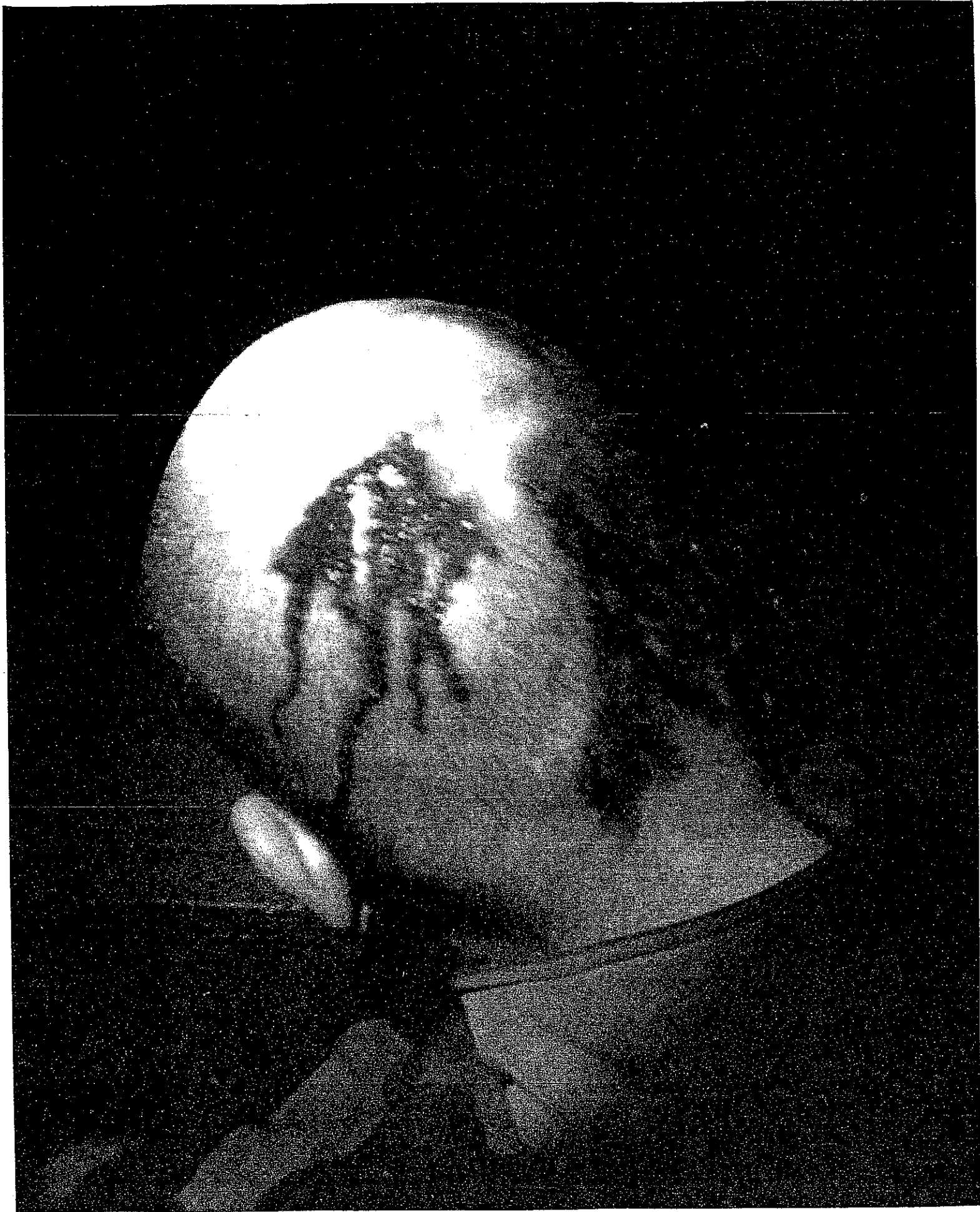
The information obtained from Exhibit DMS-22A did not meet the criteria needed to be entered into CODIS.

Exhibit DMS-22 and all DNA extracts are being retained.

The above reported frequencies were calculated following the recommendations of the National Research Council (NRCII) utilizing a validated statistical database (JFS 48(4):908-911). These numbers are an estimation for which a deviation of approximately ± 10 -fold may exist. The most common frequency from the Caucasian, African American (Blacks), or Hispanic populations is reported. The results of the amelogenin locus were not used in the statistical calculations.

Abbreviations that may appear in this report are: CODIS *Combined DNA Index System*; DNA *deoxyribonucleic acid*; PCR *Polymerase Chain Reaction*; STR *short tandem repeat*; Y-STR *male specific short tandem repeat*; FBI *Federal Bureau of Investigation*; and JFS *Journal of Forensic Sciences*.
